PRAGUE (Czech Republic)

September 19th to 24th, 2021

From 19 to 24 September 2021, the Summer University of the Czech Republic was organised once more in Prague with success and in collaboration with CEVRO Institute,

The proposed issue “Central Europe: Challenges and Opportunities” allowed a large number of different topics, all of them very relevant, and many questions and debates took place at the end of each sequence.

The 16 candidates who took part in the programme (including a girl from Vietnam on line and 3 candidates from Czeck Republic in part-time considered as auditors) were selected either by CIFE and by the partner. They represented

All the candidates who successfully completed the programme received a certificate of participation. Additionally, students who did some extra work after the session acquired ECTS Credits.

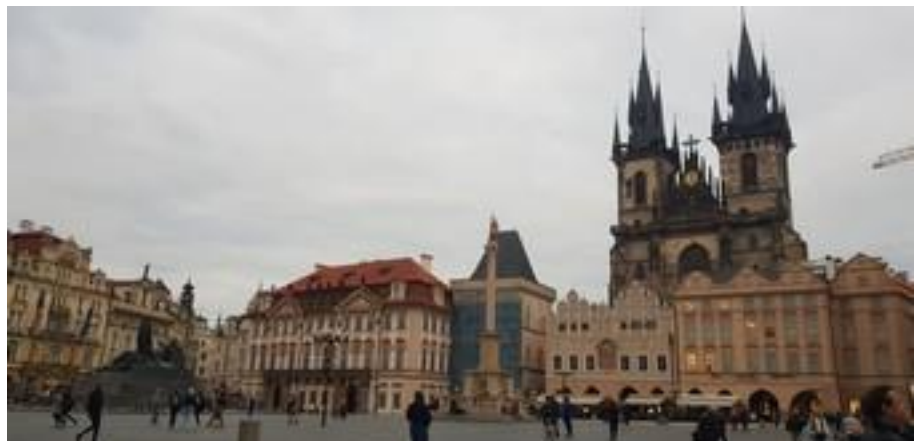
